#### **ROUND 25 SAMPLE DETAILS**

#### **BACKGROUND**

This report covers Round 25 of the Low Asbestos Content Scheme (LACS). LACS is currently a qualitative only PT scheme. Round 25 was open to laboratories worldwide. Laboratory participation was as follows: 5 UK and 125 Rest of Europe. 130 laboratories subscribed to this round - 4 laboratories didn't submit results

#### **SAMPLE**

One sample was circulated as follows: Sample LACS025 – This sample was plaster containing UICC amosite. The sample was made as a batch using 0.04% UICC amosite by mass of the whole batch sample.

#### **SCREENING & VALIDATOR INFORMATION**

The sample was prepared for circulation following our normal internal screening process of samples with representative sub-samples scanned using stereo-zoom and polarised light microscopy and transmission electron microscopy to assess homogeneity and suitability. More than 10% of the total number of samples dispatched were validated by 11 independent laboratories.

#### INFORMATION SUBMITTED BY LABORATORIES

Laboratories used the PT Online Data Entry System to submit their results for this round. Results were submitted as asbestos type(s) present.

## LACS RESULTS - Sample LACS025

Of the 126 laboratories submitting results for R25:

126 laboratories correctly reported amosite.

These results are presented graphically in Charts 1 and 2.

#### 1. Type Of Errors Obtained

Chart 1 illustrates the errors made by participating laboratories. No errors were made by laboratories on sample LACS025.

False Negative = Component has been missed. False Positive = Component has been incorrectly identified as present.

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


#### 2. Errors for UK & Non-UK Laboratories

Chart 2 illustrates the distribution of scores for all participating laboratories.

126 (100%) laboratories obtained a score of zero in this round, indicating that these laboratories had not made any errors. The distribution of scores obtained by UK (United Kingdom) and Non-UK laboratories is also compared; 5 (100%) UK laboratories and 121 (100%) Non-UK laboratories obtained a score of zero for the round.

## Chart 2 - Distribution & Comparison of Errors LACS R25




### **Ouantitative Results**
